


New Contract Award

 - State-level program planning




- In the case of reauthorization, NCHE will focus on updating publications, and providing TA and other implementation supports

Our 2009-2014 Numbers



 - Top role groups: State Coordinators, parents, local liaisons, and school staff



Title I, Part A Funding


- Formula grant program that provides funding to local educational agencies (LEAs) and schools with high numbers or high percentages of children from low-income families
- Allocated to states using four statutory formulas that are based primarily on poverty estimates and the cost of education in each state
