

REAUTHORIZATION



- The President signed the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) into law in December 2015
- EHCY was reauthorized under Title IX, Part A
- ESSA includes a number of substantive legislative changes. NCFE will incorporate these changes into its technical assistance in consultation with US ED
